FOR THE MIDSTREAM PORTION OF ROVUMA LNG PHASE 1 PROJECT
LOCATED AT AREA 4 IN THE REPUBLIC OF MOZAMBIQUE**

ExxonMobil Moçambique, Limitada (EMML) for and on behalf of Mozambique Rovuma Venture S.p.A (MRV), Operator of the Area 4 Block in the Rovuma Basin in the Republic of Mozambique invites interested companies (hereinafter collectively referred to as "Candidates" and individually as "Candidate") that are duly qualified to submit their expression of interest ("Expression of Interest") to provide engineering, procurement, and construction of Early Works as outlined herein for the Midstream portion of the Rovuma LNG Phase 1 Project located at Afungi Peninsula (Area 4) in Mozambique.

SCOPE OF WORK

The scope of work is the engineering, procurement, and construction ("EPC") of Early Works and includes the following:

- Expansion of existing 500 bed Pioneer Camp (~700 additional beds) and corresponding expansion of supporting facilities
- Construction of Permanent Camp (~2500 beds) and corresponding supporting facilities
- Performing operations, maintenance, and security services
 - For the Pioneer Camp, during the expansion and after it is completed
 - For the Permanent Camp, during the construction and after it is completed
- Clearing and Grubbing of Strategic Areas, with an estimated total area of 418,000 m²
- Engineering, procurement, fabrication, shipping, construction, installation,

commissioning, and project management of the above-mentioned scopes

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

Candidates are requested to register in the EMML Supplier Management Portal <https://prod-moz.daismp.com/>

Note: The registration must refer to the following commodity code:

LL04AE01 – CIVIL CONSTRUCTION ABOVE CEE THRESHOLD (Within the portal, under "Products & Services" tab, select EPC and Multisector Installations (LL04) > Civil Works (Residential, Industrial, Commercial) (LL04AE) > Civil Construction Above CEE Threshold (LL04AE01).

Candidates are requested to submit the documents listed below in the EMML Supplier Management Portal <https://prod-moz.daismp.com/>. After submitting the documents, Candidates are requested to send an email confirming submission to emmlprocurement@exxonmobil.com.

Cover letter including statement of interest in performing the work, company details, contact information, and the following supporting documents:

1. Organization chart of your company and a company overview highlighting the company size (turnover, number of personnel, etc.)
2. Statement on planned or potential Joint Venture, Consortium or similar corporate structure and company details of each participant, if applicable
3. Statement on local content and use of local suppliers



4. Evidence of being a major EPC contractor with proven experience in construction of camps and associated support and civil infrastructure, security systems and security infrastructure, site preparation, and camp operations, maintenance, and security services (including engineering, procurement, fabrication, shipping, construction, installation, commissioning, and project management), either by itself or through participation in a joint venture or consortium
5. Evidence the company has Foreign Corrupt Practices Act and UK Bribery Act compliance systems
6. Submission of a completed Qualification Questionnaire, which provides a more detailed list of additional criteria to establish Candidate qualifications. Note: The Qualification Questionnaire can be found and downloaded from the EMLL Supplier Management Portal <https://prod-moz.daismp.com/> as an attachment at the bottom of this Expression of Interest.

The purpose of the requested information and documents is to identify Candidates with proven capability and relevant experience. EMLL will evaluate the required documentation submitted and relevant information provided by Candidates through the Qualification Process.

Candidates will be subsequently required to sign a Confidentiality Undertaking.

Only those Candidates meeting the requirements of the Qualification Process and demonstrating relevant experience will be invited to participate in a potential invitation to tender for an EPC competitive bid, which is subject to improvement of security conditions and a decision on return of activities in the Afungi area.

This enquiry shall not be considered as an invitation to bid and does not represent or constitute any promise, offer obligation, or commitment of any kind on the part of EMLL to enter into any agreement or arrangement with Candidates nor shall it entitle your company to claim any indemnity from EMLL.

Candidates should submit an electronic version of all responses as a "native file" (e.g., in Microsoft Word, PowerPoint, Excel, or Adobe PDF format), including all supporting documents and attachments. Candidates should not submit any hard copies of any documentation requested as part of this Expression of Interest.

Candidates should not submit or otherwise disclose to EMLL any confidential or proprietary information or material.

Candidates understand that EMLL does not accept any obligation of confidence with respect to items acquired or any information disclosed by the Candidates in response to this Expression of Interest. Candidates agree that they will not place any restrictive notices on any document. However, if Candidates place a notice, EMLL is hereby authorized to nullify, obliterate, remove, or disregard any such restrictive clauses and EMLL shall be free to use or disclose any or all of the information contained thereon to affiliates and third parties without consulting with the relevant Candidates.

Any costs incurred by Candidates or any of its subcontractors replying to this Expression of Interest shall be solely the Candidates' responsibility and shall be fully born by the Candidates and shall have no recourse to EMLL.
