MozUp Showcased at MMEC 2025

MozUp participated in the Mozambique Mining and Energy Conference (MMEC) 2025, held on May 7–8 at the Joaquim Chissano Conference Center in Maputo- a premier gathering of key stakeholders driving the future of Mozambique's energy and extractive industries.

The event opened with an inspiring address from His Excellency Daniel Francisco Chapo, President of the Republic of Mozambique, who underscored

the nation's bold vision for transformation, industrialization, and sustainable growth. His remarks emphasized the critical role of strategic partnerships in unlocking the potential of natural resources to fuel inclusive economic development and regional integration.

MozUp's presence at the conference extended beyond attendance. It hosted an Small and Medium Enterprises (SME) Showcase Stand, providing a platform for six exceptional local suppliers, all selected through its Supplier Management Portal to exhibit their capabilities free-of-charge. These standout SMEs included: Afrigotel – Armazenagem Frigorífica,



SA, Kiki Catering, Lda, PRF Gás de Moçambique, Lda, RadX Construction, Lda, Técnica Engenheiros Consultores, Lda, and RosConsult, Lda.

This initiative provided businesses with an invaluable opportunity to connect directly with industry leaders, explore new partnerships, and increase visibility within the mining and energy value chains. By creating space for meaningful engagement between local enterprises and major sector players, MozUp continues to foster inclusive growth, supplier development, and long-term collaboration in Mozambique's energy future.

ISO Certification in Maputo and Pemba

As part of MozUp's ongoing commitment to improving safety, quality, and operational performance among local businesses, four standout participants from the SSHE (Safety, Security, Health, and Environment) Management Systems Training and Mentoring Program in Maputo and Pemba advanced to the ISO certification program.



This next phase supports certification in ISO 9001:2015 (Quality Management) and ISO 45001:2018 (Occupational Health and Safety Management).

Two businesses, Edil Pemba, Lda, a construction and architecture firm in Cabo Delgado, and Ping Serviços, Lda, an IT and electronics service provider in Maputo, have successfully achieved ISO 9001:2015 certification, affirming their commitment to quality and customer satisfaction. The remaining two companies are in the final stages of ISO 45001:2018 certification.

ISO certification significantly boosts a company's credibility, competitiveness, and ability to collaborate with international partners, particularly in sectors such as Oil & Gas.

Since MozUp's launch, 11 local businesses have attained certification in ISO 9001, ISO 45001, or ISO 22000, reflecting the impact of capacity-building efforts and alignment with global standards.
